



WiloStar3D Academy Student Expectations

WiloStar students must:

- Be self-starters - have the maturity and motivation to work independently and also attend and participate in our interactive campus.
- Use time wisely, be organized, be self-directed, and be willing to use new modes of communication and learning.
- Be willing to put in the needed time for course completion and immersive learning projects.
- Check communication frequently, get all assignments in on time, and discuss any concerns and questions with your teacher.
- Have regular access to a computer that meets minimum requirements.
- Have basic computer skills and be able to navigate the Internet.
- Purchase, or download necessary course materials or novels as listed in course syllabus.
- Reach out to Wilostar teachers and Wiloworlds support staff for help in both academics and 3D building.

How our 3D Campus and online course dashboard works:

- Confirm you have your username/password and know how to access both Wiloworlds and your course dashboard
- Attend the required WiloStar new student orientation session and Builder's Bootcamp.
- Establish a regular routine for checking for course communication and participating in course activities - students need to attend all live class meetings and also attend study hall four days a week. See posted times in the course dashboard.
- Read the course syllabus and check for any special instructions from the instructor - be aware of any instructor expectations as well as any assignment/activity deadlines.
- Tour your 3d classroom to become familiar with where to find assignments and activities – click on all the links and watch any intro videos.
- Follow the assignments and associated deadlines as identified on the syllabus and/or special course instructions. Meet the minimum academic progress standards outline below.
- If you have a questions or concern, contact the instructor through established course communication or Wiloworlds telegrams.

Please note: 3D Knowledge Tower project and virtual world projects are a big part of your grade. Building may be more time consuming than traditional courses so plan wisely. Online courses typically require much more reading and writing than traditional classes.

Minimum Student Behavioral and Academic Expectations:

- Students attending WiloStar3D Academy must attend a 2.5 hour online study hall in Wiloworlds M, T, Th, Fridays. Students must also log into the course dashboard every school day. Students not meeting these mandatory expectations may be referred to support services to help identify strategies to help attendance.
- Students enrolling in WiloStar for the first time are required to attend the live WiloStar3D orientation session and also watch the recorded Technical Orientation webinar. The Wiloworlds and WiloStarius Technical orientation reinforces the necessary computer skills, familiarity with essential online class functions, and awareness of strategies for online student success.
- WiloStar3D Academy students must adhere to the attendance requirements and must contact the teacher to obtain permission to miss class. Students not meeting attendance requirements may be dismissed from the school.
- WiloStar3D Academy student are required to adhere to the Student Code of Conduct, Plagiarism Policy, and Academic Dates and Deadlines stated on the WiloStar3D website – links to these are in the new student orientation site. Students with below a D average must meet with the teacher for study hall until the average is raised to at least a C.

- Internet Connection, high speed or DSL recommended
